## **ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS**

- Facility is in the U.S, operated by the U.S. government, or operated under a charter of the U.S. Congress.
- Facility designs a program that:
- Uses a standardized method of delivering services based on current science-based American Heart Association guidelines
- Participating facilities must offer education and opportunities for residents to work toward improved health in the following health categories:
  - Smoking Status
  - o Physical Activity
  - Healthy Diet
  - o Healthy Weight
  - Depression & Anxiety
  - Sleep
  - o Stress management
  - o Alcohol (in Moderation)
  - Immunizations
  - o Prevention, Lifestyle, and Risk Reduction

### **CERTIFICATION TERM**

Facilities are certified for a three-year term

#### FEES

Healthy Senior Living Center Certification is \$4,500 annually for a three- year certification

### **REQUIREMENTS OVERVIEW**

### **REQUIREMENT 1.0 PROGRAM MANAGEMENT**

The Healthy Senior Living Program defines its mission, goals, scope, and organizational structure. It identifies a Program Champion and organizes a committee that oversees the Healthy Senior Living Program.

### REQUIREMENT 2.0 HEALTHY SENIOR LIVING PROGRAM

The Healthy Senior Living Program creates a culture of health for residents and has implemented opportunities and education for residents to work toward improved quality of health.

### **REQUIREMENT 3.0 PERSONNEL EDUCATION**

Staff has received the education to promote and offer Healthy Senior Living Program opportunities to residents and their caregiver.
